

Senate Bill 5513

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Fish and Wildlife; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) Fish Division:

(a) Fish propagation \$ 4,647,073

(b) Fish natural production \$ 3,136,384

(c) Fish marine resources \$ 476,193

(2) Wildlife Division:

(a) Wildlife management \$ 324,543

(b) Wildlife habitat resources..... \$ 667,645

(c) Wildlife conservation \$ 1,081,165

(3) Administrative Services

Division \$ 1,293,426

(4) Debt service \$ 350,262

(5) Capital improvement..... \$ 157,553

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

(1) Fish Division:

(a) Fish propagation \$ 12,465,357

18 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, for the following purposes:
