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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Judicial Department for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from bond proceeds for payment of certain expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

5	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium begin-
6	ning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, of which the department
7	may expend up to 54 percent during the period beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30,
8	2012, for the following purposes:
9	(1) Judicial compensation \$ 62,872,712

11	(3) Mandated payments \$ 12,889,672
12	(4) Electronic court \$ 2,000,000

14	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts

1 \$10,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for

payment of expenses for electronic court from bond proceeds collected or received by the
Judicial Department.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$850,620 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2011 Act collected

8 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 10 July 1, 2011.
