

Senate Bill 5520

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel Committee, Legislative Fiscal Officer, Legislative Revenue Officer and Commission on Indian Services for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by certain legislative branch agencies.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of legislative branch agencies; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following purposes:

(1) General program..... \$ 11,649,760

(2) Debt service..... \$ 6,768,675

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,115,390 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Administration Committee.

SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Legislative Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$37,957,590.

SECTION 5. Notwithstanding ORS 293.190, any moneys remaining from the appropriations made by sections 4 and 5 (2), chapter 676, Oregon Laws 2009, on June 30, 2011, are transferred to the Emergency Board on July 1, 2011, to be available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$268,970 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Assembly of

1 the State of Oregon.

2 **SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Legislative
3 Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117 for the costs of
4 food served in members' lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or
5 by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

6 **SECTION 8.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
7 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$9,409,507.

8 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
9 \$1,635,785 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
10 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
11 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
12 Committee.

13 **SECTION 10.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Legislative
14 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from
15 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
16 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
17 Statutes, are not limited.

18 **SECTION 11.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
19 beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,582,859.

20 **SECTION 12.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
21 beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,354,579.

22 **SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
23 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$455,630.

24 **SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,431
25 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of
26 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
27 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian
28 Services.

29 **SECTION 15.** This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
30 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
31 July 1, 2011.

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
