SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Library for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including certain Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Library. Limits biennial expenditures by State Library from assessment against state agencies. Limits biennial expenditures by State Library from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Library; appropriating money; limiting expen-

3 ditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Library, for the biennium beginning July 6 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,802,078.

7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$942,982

is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of
expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts other than
those described in section 3 of this 2011 Act, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,

11 collected or received by the State Library.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 13 \$5,475,640 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 14 payment of expenses from moneys received from the assessment against state agencies de-15 scribed in ORS 357.203 and transferred to the Miscellaneous Receipts Account for the State 16 Library.

17 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 18 \$4,749,472 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 19 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Library.

20 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 21 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 22 July 1, 2011.
