3 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
 4 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment
 5 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
 6 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon University Sys-
 7 tem for the following purposes:

- 8 (1) Education and general services

- 10 (2) Agricultural Experiment Station
 11 and the branch experiment
 12 stations of Oregon State
 13 University \$ 10,723,789

- 18 (5) Capital improvement..... \$ 41,000,000
- 19 (6) Debt service \$ 23,541,337

20 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
 21 \$11,335,315 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
 22 payment of expenses from funds allocated to the Oregon University System from the Sports
 23 Lottery Account.

24 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
 25 \$17,180,329 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
 26 payment of expenses by the Oregon University System from lottery moneys allocated from
 27 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt service on lottery bonds.

28 **SECTION 5.** (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Oregon
 29 University System of moneys from gift, grant and contract activities, noncredit continuing
 30 education, auxiliary enterprise activities, user fee-supported education and public service
 31 activities and student aid programs, excluding fee remissions, for gift, grant and contract
 32 activities, noncredit continuing education, auxiliary enterprise activities, user fee-supported
 33 education and public service activities and student aid programs, excluding fee remissions,
 34 are not limited.

35 (2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Oregon University Sys-
 36 tem of moneys from fees, moneys or other revenues for debt service or for administrative
 37 costs relating to debt service on bonds sold pursuant to Article XI-F(1) of the Oregon Con-
 38 stitution, are not limited.

39 (3) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Oregon University Sys-
 40 tem of moneys from fees, moneys or other revenues, other than those appropriated under
 41 section 1 of this 2011 Act, for debt service, for administrative costs relating to debt service
 42 on outstanding certificates of participation and for repayment of energy loans to the State
 43 Department of Energy are not limited.

44 (4) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Oregon University Sys-
 45 tem from federal funds for debt service on Build America Bonds are not limited.

1 **SECTION 6. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
2 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
3 **July 1, 2011.**
