**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

**Increases expenditure limit for biennium beginning July 1, 2009, from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.**

Declares emergency, effective *[July 1, 2011]* on passage.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission; limiting  
3 expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
6 **\$5,437,245 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for**  
7 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
8 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Teacher Standards**  
9 **and Practices Commission.**

10 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
11 **expenditures established by section 1, chapter 120, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium be-**  
12 **ginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**  
13 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**  
14 **funds, collected or received by the Teachers Standards and Practices Commission is in-**  
15 **creased by \$206,000.**

16 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
18 **on its passage.**
