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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Veterans' Affairs for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the
6	biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, of which
7	the department may expend up to 54 percent during the period beginning July 1, 2011, and
8	ending June 30, 2012, for payment of expenses for services supplied to veterans:

12	(2) For payments to counties

15	(3) For payments to veterans'

18	SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
19	\$44,930,719 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
20	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts
21	and the Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and fed-
22	eral funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for administration,
23	grants and services supplied to veterans.

24 (2) This section does not limit expenditures from the Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking

2 <u>SECTION 3.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Department

3 of Veterans' Affairs for the following purposes are not limited:

- 4 (1) Debt service;
- 5 (2) Professional services and related costs associated directly with bond sales;

6 (3) Loans to veterans; and

7 (4) Payments on behalf of borrowers for property taxes, city liens, fire insurance, mort-8 gage cancellation insurance and repairs to and miscellaneous charges for borrower-owned 9 property that are charged to the loan account and repaid along with the payment of loan 10 interest and principal.

SECTION 4. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
July 1, 2011.

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
