

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5547

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 25 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund  
3 established under ORS 541.379, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate  
4 \$5,965,774 to the Department of State Police for fish and wildlife activities to implement  
5 section 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

6 “**SECTION 2.** Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund  
7 established under ORS 541.379, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate  
8 \$5,824,398 to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife for activities and projects to imple-  
9 ment section 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

10 “**SECTION 3.** Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund  
11 established under ORS 541.379, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate  
12 \$6,335,856 to the State Department of Agriculture for activities and projects to implement  
13 section 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

14 “**SECTION 4.** Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund  
15 established under ORS 541.379, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate  
16 \$4,503,053 to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to imple-  
17 ment section 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

18 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
19 \$9,784,507 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for  
20 payment of expenses by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board from lottery moneys  
21 deposited into the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund established under ORS 541.379,  
22 for operating expenses, activities and projects to implement section 4 (8), Article XV of the  
23 Oregon Constitution.

24 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
25 \$45,479,409 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for  
26 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Watershed En-  
27 hancement Board.

28 “**SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
29 \$1,773,549 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for  
30 payment of expenses for operations related to Oregon Plan activities from fees, moneys or  
31 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal  
32 funds, collected or received by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board.

33 “**SECTION 8.** (1) The Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall establish by rule a  
34 process for allocating on a quarterly basis available moneys in the Natural Resources Sub-  
35 account of the Parks and Natural Resources Fund, established under ORS 541.351 to 541.415,

1 to fulfill the biennial allocations made in this 2011 Act. Except as provided in subsection (2)  
2 of this section, all quarterly allocations shall be set at one-eighth of the biennial allocations.

3 “(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the Oregon State Lottery Fund to  
4 the Parks and Natural Resources Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations  
5 established under subsection (1) of this section, the allocations shall be reduced proportion-  
6 ately by amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

7 “SECTION 9. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect  
9 July 1, 2011.”

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
