

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5551

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

March 23

In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “appropriating money” and insert “amending sections 6, 9 and 10, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009; repealing section 17, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009”.

Delete lines 5 through 16 and insert:

“**SECTION 1.** Section 6, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 3, chapter 99, Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

“**Sec. 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses under this section from bond proceeds and other revenues, including federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon University System, for the acquisition of land, improvements to land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of buildings, facilities and other projects within the Oregon University System:

16 **“SECTION 2.** Section 9, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 6, chapter 99,
17 Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

18 **“Sec. 9.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the project approvals and ex-
19 penditure limitations in chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, and the expenditure limitations established
20 by the Emergency Board during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, for capital construction or
21 acquisition projects of the Oregon University System and of the Department of Community Colleges
22 and Workforce Development for community colleges, expire on June 30, 2015, unless otherwise noted
23 or unless changed by the Legislative Assembly.

24 “(2) The project approvals and expenditure limitations established by section 2 (5)(b), (e) and (i),
25 chapter 725, Oregon Laws 2003, and section 2 (3)(h), chapter 845, Oregon Laws 2001, for capital
26 construction or acquisition projects of the Oregon University System expire on June 30, 2011, unless
27 otherwise changed by the Legislative Assembly.

28 “(3) The project approvals and expenditure limitations in section 6 (4)(c), (k) and (L), (5)(c) and
29 (e) and (7)(k), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, and the expenditure limitations established by the
30 Emergency Board during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, for capital construction or acquisition
31 projects of the Oregon University System described in section 6 (4)(c), (k) and (L), (5)(c) and (e) and
32 (7)(k), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, expire on June 30, 2015, unless otherwise noted or unless
33 changed by the Legislative Assembly.

34 **“(4) The project approvals and expenditure limitations in section 6 (1)(a), (2)(b), (4)(b),**
35 **(6)(a) and (7)(b) and (c), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, expire on June 30, 2015, unless pro-**
36 **vided otherwise.**

37 **“SECTION 3.** Section 10, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 7, chapter 99,
38 Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

39 **“Sec. 10.** (1) Pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution and ORS 351.345 and ORS
40 chapter 286A, the State Board of Higher Education may sell, with the approval of the State Treas-
41 urer, general obligation bonds of the State of Oregon of the kind and character and within the limits
42 prescribed by Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, as the board determines, but in no event may
43 the board sell more than the aggregate principal sum of [\$143,900,479] **\$139,900,479** par value for the
44 biennium beginning July 1, 2009. The moneys realized from the sale of the bonds shall be appropri-
45 ated and may be expended for the purposes set forth in section 2 (3)(h), chapter 845, Oregon Laws

1 2001, section 2 (6)(h) and (p), chapter 787, Oregon Laws 2005, section 2 (4)(a) and (L), (5)(h) and (6)(g)
2 and (h), chapter 761, Oregon Laws 2007, **and** section 6 (1)(b) and (d), (2)(a) [*and (b)*], (3), (4)(b), (c)
3 and (d), (5)(a), (6)(b) and (7)(a), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, and for payment for capitalized in-
4 terest and costs incidental to issuance of the bonds.

5 “(2) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
6 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
7 Constitution in section 6 (1)(b), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
8 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 14, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

9 “(3) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
10 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
11 Constitution in section 6 (1)(d), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
12 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 15, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

13 “(4) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
14 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
15 Constitution in section 6 (2)(a), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
16 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 16, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

17 “[5] *In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds avail-*
18 *able under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon Consti-*
19 *tution in section 6 (2)(b), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched with the General Fund*
20 *appropriation made under section 17, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.*]

21 “[6] (5) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
22 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
23 Constitution in section 6 (3), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
24 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 18, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

25 “[7] (6) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
26 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
27 Constitution in section 6 (4)(b), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
28 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 19, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

29 “[8] (7) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
30 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
31 Constitution in section 6 (4)(c), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
32 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 20, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

33 “[9] (8) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
34 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
35 Constitution in section 6 (4)(d), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
36 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 21, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

37 “[10] (9) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, funds
38 available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the Oregon
39 Constitution in section 6 (5)(a), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the General Fund*
40 *appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 22, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

41 “[11] (10) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution,
42 funds available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the
43 Oregon Constitution in section 6 (6)(b), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the Gen-*
44 *eral Fund appropriation made under*] **pursuant to** section 23, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

45 “[12] (11) In compliance with the requirements of Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution,

1 funds available under the expenditure limitation for bonds issued pursuant to Article XI-G of the
2 Oregon Constitution in section 6 (7)(a), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are matched [*with the Gen-*
3 *eral Fund appropriation made under*] pursuant to section 24, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009.

4 **“SECTION 4. Section 17, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, is repealed.**

5 **“SECTION 5. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
6 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
7 **on its passage.”.**
