## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [\_\_\_\_] **Department of Education** for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys allocated from Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to department for State School Fund.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [\_\_\_\_] department for State School Fund.

Prohibits and caps, for biennium, specified uses of moneys from State School Fund. Specifies, for 2011 and 2012 fiscal years, total amount that department may spend from State School Fund.

Limits, for fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, expenditures by department from lottery moneys transferred from Education Stability Fund to 2011-2012 School Year Subaccount.

[Limits biennial expenditures of \_\_\_\_ from federal funds.] Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,204,741,308 for the State School Fund.
  - <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$371,918,440 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
  - SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$340,252 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
  - SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, the Department of Education:
- (1) May not expend any moneys from the State School Fund for the administration of ORS 326.133 and 326.136.

  - SECTION 7. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
