SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5552

1	Delete lines 5 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
3	priated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the
4	General Fund, the amount of \$5,204,741,308 for the State School Fund.
5	" <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
6	\$371,918,440 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
7	payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
8	nomic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
9	"SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
10	\$340,252 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
11	payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues,
12	including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or
13	received by the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
14	"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July
15	1, 2011, the Department of Education:
16	"(1) May not expend any moneys from the State School Fund for the administration of
17	ORS 326.133 and 326.136.
18	"(2) May expend up to \$968,000 from the State School Fund for the contract described in
19	ORS 329.488.
20	"(3) May expend up to \$1,584,000 from the State School Fund for the purposes of the
21	Oregon Virtual School District.
22	" <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The Department of Education may not spend more than \$2,850,000,000
23	from the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011.
24	"(2) The Department of Education may not spend more than \$2,850,000,000 from the State
25	School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012.
26	" <u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, for the fiscal year
27	ending June 30, 2012, the amount of \$100 million is established as the maximum limit for
28	payment of expenses by the Department of Education from lottery moneys transferred from
29	the Education Stability Fund to the 2011-2012 School Year Subaccount established by section
30	2, chapter, Oregon Laws 2011 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5553).
31	" <u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
32	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
33	July 1, 2011.".
