

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5554

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

May 23

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “appropriating money;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 16 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
4 **expenditures established by section 2, chapter 723, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium be-**  
5 **ginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**  
6 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**  
7 **funds, collected or received by the Judicial Department, is increased by \$4,009,379.**

8 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**  
9 **established by section 3, chapter 723, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1,**  
10 **2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received**  
11 **by the Judicial Department, is increased by \$260,000.**

12 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
13 **expenditures established by section 2, chapter 723, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium be-**  
14 **ginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**  
15 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**  
16 **funds, collected or received by the Judicial Department, is increased by \$4,800,000.**

17 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**  
18 **established by section 20 (2), chapter 910, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July**  
19 **1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,**  
20 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or**  
21 **received by the Judicial Department for electronic court, is decreased by \$4,800,000.**

22 **“SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
23 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
24 **on its passage.”.**
