## Senate Bill 567

Sponsored by Senator EDWARDS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to establish endorsement in autism spectrum disorders. Specifies requirements for person to qualify for endorsement.

<b>2</b>	Relating to teacher specialization in autism spectrum disorder.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 342.
5	SECTION 2. (1) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission shall establish an
6	endorsement in autism spectrum disorders.
7	(2) An endorsement in autism spectrum disorders may be granted only to a person who:
8	(a) Holds a continuing teaching license with an endorsement in special education or who
9	holds a license as a school psychologist or a speech-language pathologist;
10	(b) Has a minimum of three years of experience in providing instruction to students with
11	autism spectrum disorders, which may include participation in a planned education program
12	consisting of courses taken at an approved teacher education institution or participation in
13	an in-service training program; and
14	(c) Meets any other standards established by the commission by rule after consulting
15	with experts on autism spectrum disorders.
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
