

# Senate Bill 571

Sponsored by Senator NELSON, Representative G SMITH

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for payment to Investing in Boardman's Healthy Future Capital Campaign.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to funding for nonprofit health care provider in Boardman, Oregon; appropriating money;  
3 and declaring an emergency.

4 Whereas Columbia River Community Health Services, a Boardman, Oregon, nonprofit organiza-  
5 tion, provides high-quality health care and occupational services to one of Oregon's fastest growing  
6 communities; and

7 Whereas Columbia River Community Health Services has experienced a 240-percent increase in  
8 growth; and

9 Whereas Columbia River Community Health Services hosted 12,000 patient visits in a community  
10 of 3,310 residents in 2009; and

11 Whereas the Investing in Boardman's Healthy Future Capital Campaign has raised 81 percent  
12 of the funding needed to break ground on a new facility through pledges, grants and in-kind revenue  
13 and has actively solicited other funding as well; now, therefore,

14 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

15 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,**  
16 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$400,000 to**  
17 **be paid into the Investing in Boardman's Healthy Future Capital Campaign for the benefit**  
18 **of Columbia River Community Health Services.**

19 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
21 **July 1, 2011.**
