## Senate Bill 597

Sponsored by Senator ATKINSON

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Legislative Assembly to leave unappropriated three percent of amount of General Fund revenues estimated to be available for biennium.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to state finance. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. In budgeting for a biennium that begins on July 1 of an odd-numbered year, 4 the Legislative Assembly shall leave unappropriated three percent of the amount of General 5 Fund revenues estimated to be available for the biennium. The Legislative Assembly shall use the estimate of General Fund revenues contained in the last quarterly economic and 8 revenue forecast presented prior to the end of the regular legislative session in that year. For purposes of this section, the quarterly economic and revenue forecast is the forecast made for purposes of section 4 (6), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution. 10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act first applies to the biennium beginning July 1, 2013. 11 12
