

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 600

June 22

Amended Summary

Modifies provisions related to lease of submersible lands. Modifies provisions related to easements over submersible lands. Modifies provisions related to certain privately owned floats and docks. Allows Department of State Lands to authorize, without charge, certain uses of submerged and submersible lands. Modifies provisions related to kelp fields. Allows Department of State Lands to *[adopt rule that exempts from removal-fill requirements]* **establish by rule general permit allowing** removal of no more than 100 cubic yards of material from waters of state for purpose of maintaining drainage and protecting agricultural land.

President Courtney:

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred B-engrossed Senate Bill 600, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the Senate concur in the House amendments dated June 6 and that the bill be amended as follows and repassed.

1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, delete "196.905,".

2 On page 4, delete lines 40 through 45 and delete pages 5 through 7.

3 On page 8, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert:

4 **"SECTION 6. Section 7 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 196.800 to**
5 **196.825.**

6 **"SECTION 7. Notwithstanding ORS 196.810, the Department of State Lands may establish**
7 **by rule a general permit that allows the removal of no more than 100 cubic yards of material**
8 **from waters of this state, including in essential indigenous anadromous salmonid habitat, for**
9 **the purpose of maintaining drainage and protecting agricultural land. The department may**
10 **waive the fees specified in ORS 196.815 for removal taking place under the provisions of this**
11 **section."**

12 On page 9, delete lines 12 and 13.
