

# Senate Bill 614

Sponsored by Senator STARR

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to examine cost of completing Oregon's portion of Columbia River Crossing Project.

Sunsets January 2, 2014.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the Columbia River Crossing Project; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall undertake a study to examine**  
5 **the cost of completing Oregon's portion of the Columbia River Crossing Project.**

6 **(2) The department shall report the results of the study to the Seventy-seventh Legisla-**  
7 **tive Assembly.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
