SUMMARY

[Directs] Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain children's psychiatric access telephone line.

2	Relating to a children's psychiatric access telephone line.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may establish and maintain a children's
5	psychiatric access telephone line program that:
6	(a) Provides assistance to primary care practitioners treating children from birth to 18
7	years of age;
8	(b) Is accessible Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.;
9	(c) Is accessible throughout this state;
10	(d) Provides face-to-face consultation for patients who have a high level of need; and
11	(e) Provides face-to-face consultation by electronic means for patients in rural settings.
12	(2) The authority may accept gifts, grants or contributions from any public or private
13	source for the purpose of carrying out this section.
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
