## Senate Bill 64

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## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Restricts application of Uniform Act on Blood Tests to Determine Paternity in criminal cases to criminal nonsupport cases only.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to paternity blood tests in criminal cases; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 3 109.260. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 5 SECTION 1. ORS 109.260 is amended to read: 6 109.260. ORS 109.250 to 109.262 [shall] apply to criminal cases for nonsupport under ORS 7 163.555 subject to the following limitations and provisions: 8 (1) An order for the tests shall be made only upon application of a party or on the court's ini-9 tiative. 10 (2) The compensation of the experts shall be paid by the county in which the proceedings are 11 had under order of court. 12 (3) The court may direct a verdict of acquittal upon the conclusions of all the experts under the provisions of ORS 109.258, otherwise the case shall be submitted for determination upon all evi-13 14 dence. 15 SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 109.260 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to 16 criminal cases pending before, on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
