Senate Bill 649

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to conduct feasibility study regarding development of zone to improve fish habitat in specified areas. Directs department to report on study to Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly on or before February 1, 2013.

Sunsets January 2, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the North Santiam River.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall conduct a feasibility study regarding the development of a zone to improve fish habitat:
 - (a) Between the Upper Bennett Dam and the confluence of Gardner Ditch with the main stem of the North Santiam River; and
 - (b) Between the Lower Bennett Dam and the confluence of Gardner Ditch with the main stem of the North Santiam River.
 - (2) In conducting the study, the department shall consult with other state agencies having a common interest in fish habitat improvement, the Santiam Water Control District, the City of Stayton and the City of Salem.
 - (3) The department shall report the results of the study to the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly not later than February 1, 2013.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.
