

Senate Bill 702

Sponsored by Senator ATKINSON; Senators KRUSE, STARR

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires state employees who participate in benefit plan provided by state to contribute 15 percent of cost of premiums for coverage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to payment of premiums for benefit plan provided to state employees.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.105 to**
5 **243.285.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of ORS 243.105 to 243.285, an eligible**
7 **employee who participates in a benefit plan shall contribute 15 percent of the premium ex-**
8 **penditure for the coverage provided.**

9 **(2) A collective bargaining agreement between the State of Oregon and the exclusive**
10 **representative of public employees must require that an eligible employee who participates**
11 **in a benefit plan contribute 15 percent of the premium expense for the coverage provided.**

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to agreements entered into on or after the**
13 **effective date of this 2011 Act.**
