1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and
2	delete line 3 and insert "and declaring an emergency.
3	"Whereas the efficient allocation of supervision resources requires providing community cor-
4	rections agencies with the authority to focus staff, services and sanctions on offenders in need of
5	monitoring and behavioral intervention; and
6	"Whereas offenders who are compliant with supervision and have fulfilled court-ordered obli-
7	gations do not require ongoing supervision; and
8	"Whereas alleviating the obligation to supervise compliant offenders allows community cor-
9	rections agencies to more closely supervise offenders who constitute a greater threat to public order
10	and safety; and
11	"Whereas allowing an offender to earn an early termination of supervision enhances motivation,
12	promotes behavior change and provides incentives to meet the goals and conditions of supervision;
13	now, therefore,".
14	Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
15	"SECTION 1. (1) Each person convicted of a felony and sentenced to probation under the
16	rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission is eligible for a reduction in the period of
17	probation for compliance with the conditions of probation and the person's supervision plan,
18	as defined by rule of the Department of Corrections.
19	"(2) The maximum reduction in the period of probation may not exceed 50 percent of the
20	period of probation imposed by the court.
21	"(3) The department shall adopt rules to establish a process for granting, retracting and
22	restoring probation credits earned by offenders under this section. A community corrections
23	agency shall comply with the rules adopted under this section.
24	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act applies to persons:
25	"(1) Convicted of a crime committed on or after July 1, 2011; and
26	"(2) Who are on probation on or after the effective date of the rules adopted by the De-
27	partment of Corrections under section 1 (3) of this 2011 Act.
28	"SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
29	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect

on its passage.".
