

Senate Bill 737

Sponsored by Senator MONROE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to post to their websites rates and fee schedules for payments to residential and community-based care providers.

2 Relating to public disclosure of reimbursement paid to residential care providers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) "Adult foster home" has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.705.

6 (b) "Child-caring agency" has the meaning given that term in ORS 418.205.

7 (c) "Developmental disability child foster home" has the meaning given that term in ORS
8 443.830.

9 (d) "Long term care facility" has the meaning given that term in ORS 442.015.

10 (e) "Residential care facility" has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.400.

11 (2) The Department of Human Services shall make available on the department's website
12 the rates and fee schedules paid by the department to providers that provide residential care
13 or services to clients of the department, including:

14 (a) Adult foster homes;

15 (b) Child-caring agencies that provide residential care;

16 (c) Developmental disability child foster homes;

17 (d) Long term care facilities;

18 (e) Residential care facilities; and

19 (f) Any provider paid by the department to provide community-based care.

20 (3) Information made available under this section shall be published for each type of fa-
21 cility or provider for which the department establishes a separate rate or fee.

22 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

23 (a) "Adult foster home" has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.705.

24 (b) "Long term care facility" has the meaning given that term in ORS 442.015.

25 (c) "Residential care facility" has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.400.

26 (2) The Oregon Health Authority shall make available on the authority's website the
27 rates and fee schedules paid by the authority to providers that provide residential care or
28 services to recipients of medical assistance, including:

29 (a) Adult foster homes;

30 (b) Long term care facilities;

31 (c) Residential care facilities; and
