

Senate Bill 779

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Early Childhood Services for purpose of identifying most efficient methods for funding programs that provide early childhood services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to early childhood services; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Early Childhood Services is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of members who are appointed by the Governor and who serve**
6 **at the pleasure of the Governor.**

7 **(3) The task force shall identify the most efficient methods for funding programs that**
8 **provide early childhood services.**

9 **(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction**
10 **of business.**

11 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
12 **of the task force.**

13 **(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

14 **(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment to be-**
15 **come immediately effective.**

16 **(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
17 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

18 **(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

19 **(10) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**
20 **lation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later**
21 **than October 1, 2012.**

22 **(11) The task force shall use the services of permanent staff of the office of the Gover-**
23 **nor.**

24 **(12) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for**
25 **expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

26 **(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
27 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
28 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
29 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

30 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2013**
31 **regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
2 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
3 **on its passage.**

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
