Senate Bill 794

SUMMARY

Adds criterion to be considered when apportioning state into congressional and legislative districts.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to redistricting; amending ORS 188.010.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 188.010 is amended to read:

5 188.010. The Legislative Assembly or the Secretary of State, whichever is applicable, shall con-

6 sider the following criteria when apportioning the state into congressional and legislative districts:

7 (1) Each district, as nearly as practicable, shall:

8 (a) Be contiguous;

- 9 (b) Be of equal population;
- 10 (c) Utilize existing geographic or political boundaries;

11 (d) Not divide communities of common interest; [and]

12 (e) Contain as much of a single county as possible; and

13 [(e)] (f) Be connected by transportation links.

(2) [No] A district [shall] may not be drawn for the purpose of favoring any political party,
incumbent legislator or other person.

16 (3) [No] **A** district [shall] **may not** be drawn for the purpose of diluting the voting strength of 17 any language or ethnic minority group.

(4) Two state House of Representative districts shall be wholly included within a single statesenatorial district.
