SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits adoption or enforcement by Land Conservation and Development Commission of transportation planning rule with specified function. Sunsets provision January 2, 2017.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- SECTION 1. The Land Conservation and Development Commission may not adopt or en-4 force an administrative rule that requires local governments to implement measures to en-5
- sure or assure that land uses that are allowed under an amendment to a comprehensive plan, 6
- functional plan or land use regulation that significantly affects existing or planned trans-
- portation facilities are consistent with the function, capacity or performance standards of 8 9 the transportation facilities.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed January 2, 2017. 10
 - SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect on its passage.
