HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 803

On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, after "163.693;" insert "repealing section 1, 1 $\mathbf{2}$ chapter 109, Oregon Laws 2011 (Enrolled House Bill 2463);". 3 On page 4, after line 14, insert: "SECTION 11a. If House Bill 2463 becomes law, section 1, chapter 109, Oregon Laws 2011 4 (Enrolled House Bill 2463) (amending ORS 163.693), is repealed and ORS 163.693, as amended $\mathbf{5}$ 6 by section 8 of this 2011 Act, is amended to read: 7 "163.693. [(1) A person commits the crime of failure to report child pornography if the person, in the course of processing or producing a visual recording, either commercially or privately, has rea-8 9 sonable cause to believe that the visual recording being processed or produced, or submitted for pro-10 cessing or production, depicts sexually explicit conduct involving a child and fails to report that fact 11 to the appropriate law enforcement agency.] 12"[(2) Failure to report child pornography is a Class A misdemeanor.] 13 "(1) As used in this section: 14 "(a) 'Computer technician' means a person who repairs, installs or otherwise services a 15computer, computer network or computer system for compensation. 16 "(b) 'Processor of photographic images' means a person who develops, processes, re-17 produces, transfers, edits or enhances photographic film into negatives, slides, prints, mov-18 ies, digital images or video. 19 "(2) A processor of photographic images or a computer technician who reasonably be-20 lieves the processor or technician has observed a visual recording of a child involved in 21sexually explicit conduct shall report the name and address, if known, of the person re-22questing the processing or of the owner or person in possession of the computer, computer 23 network or computer system to: 24 "(a) The CyberTipline at the National Center for Missing and Exploited children; 25"(b) The local office of the Department of Human Services; or 26"(c) A law enforcement agency within the county where the processor or technician 27making the report is located at the time the visual recording is observed. 28"(3) Nothing in this section requires a processor of photographic images or a computer 29technician to monitor any user, subscriber or customer or to search for prohibited materials 30 or media. 31 "(4) Any person, their employer or a third party complying with this section in good faith 32shall be immune from civil or criminal liability in connection with making the report, except 33 for willful or wanton misconduct. 34 "(5) A person commits the crime of failure to report child pornography if the person vi-

35 olates the provisions of this section.

- 1 "(6) Failure to report child pornography is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 2 "SECTION 11b. If House Bill 2463 becomes law, the amendments to ORS 163.693 by sec-
- 3 tion 11a of this 2011 Act become operative on January 1, 2012.".
