1	Delete lines 4 through 17 of the printed bill and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
3	"(a) 'Commercial or industrial property' means property that is not used primarily for
4	residential occupancy or for local government purposes.
5	"(b) 'Local government' has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.116.
6	"(c) 'Xeriscaping' means the selection of drought tolerant plants, the minimization of
7	evaporation and runoff and the use of other landscape design features that minimize the
8	need of the landscape for supplemental water from irrigation.
9	"(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, an owner or occupant of a
10	commercial or industrial property may install xeriscaping on landscaped portions of the
11	property that are not otherwise set aside, dedicated or used to comply with a local govern-
12	ment ordinance, rule or regulation regarding:
13	"(a) Stormwater management;
14	"(b) The preservation of natural habitat and tree canopy; or
15	"(c) The control of invasive plant species.
16	"(3) Subsection (2) of this section does not prohibit a local government from enforcing
17	any contractual right of the local government with regard to the installation and mainte-
18	nance of landscaping for a commercial or industrial structure developed in whole or in part
19	with funding provided by the local government.".
