Senate Bill 807

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits public body from releasing information that identifies holder of or applicant for concealed handgun license. Authorizes disclosure for criminal justice purposes or pursuant to court order.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to prohibiting public disclosure of concealed handgun license information. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. A public body as defined in ORS 192.410 may not disclose records or information that identify a person as a current holder of, or applicant for, a concealed handgun 5 license unless: 6 7 (1) The disclosure is necessary for criminal justice purposes; or (2) A court enters an order in a pending civil or criminal case directing the public body 8 to disclose the records or information. 9 10
