

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 82

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert “459.247,”.
- 2 On page 10, after line 40, insert:
- 3 “**SECTION 10.** ORS 459.247 is amended to read:
- 4 “459.247. (1) No person shall dispose of and no disposal site operator shall knowingly accept for
- 5 disposal the following types of solid waste at a solid waste disposal site:
- 6 “(a) Discarded or abandoned vehicles;
- 7 “(b) Discarded large home or industrial appliances;
- 8 “(c) Used oil;
- 9 “(d) Tires;
- 10 “(e) Lead-acid batteries; or
- 11 “(f) Covered electronic devices.
- 12 “(2) As used in this section:
- 13 “(a) ‘Covered electronic device’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 459A.305, **except that**
- 14 **‘covered electronic device’ does not include a computer peripheral or a printer as those items**
- 15 **are defined in ORS 459A.305; and**
- 16 “(b) ‘Used oil’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 459A.555.
- 17 “(3) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a disposal site operator from accepting and storing,
- 18 for purposes of recycling or recovering, any of the types of solid waste listed in subsection (1) of this
- 19 section.
- 20 “(4) The Environmental Quality Commission may postpone the prohibition under subsection (1)(f)
- 21 of this section in any area of this state where the commission determines there is an inadequate
- 22 system for the collection, transportation and recycling of covered electronic devices.
- 23 “(5)(a) Each disposal site operator shall establish and implement, in accordance with any permit
- 24 requirements established by the Department of Environmental Quality, a program reasonably de-
- 25 signed to prevent acceptance of covered electronic devices for disposal. If an operator operates the
- 26 disposal site in conformity with the program, the operator is presumed to have complied with the
- 27 provisions of this section that prohibit knowingly accepting covered electronic devices for disposal.
- 28 “(b) This section does not prevent the disposal site operator from accepting and storing, for
- 29 purposes of recycling, reusing or refurbishing, covered electronic devices.”.
- 30 In line 41, delete “10” and insert “11”.
- 31 In line 44, after “ORS” insert “459.247,”.
- 32 In line 45, delete “9” and insert “10”.
- 33 On page 11, line 8, after “ORS” insert “459.247,”.
- 34 In line 9, delete “9” and insert “10”.
- 35 In line 10, delete “11” and insert “12”.
