Senate Bill 822

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Extends sunsets for tax credits for use of alternative fuel vehicles and for construction or installation of fueling stations for alternative fuel vehicles. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Section 14, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009, is amended to read: $\mathbf{5}$ Sec. 14. A credit may not be claimed under ORS 317.115 for tax years beginning on or after 6 January 1, [2012] 2018. 7 8 SECTION 2. Section 5a, chapter 832, Oregon Laws 2005, as amended by section 35, chapter 843, Oregon Laws 2007, and section 12, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009, is amended to read: 9 Sec. 5a. (1) A taxpayer may not be allowed a credit under ORS 316.116 if the first tax year for 10 which the credit would otherwise be allowed with respect to an [alternative energy device or] alter-11 12 native fuel vehicle or related equipment [is] begins on or after January 1, [2012] 2018. (2) A taxpayer may not be allowed a credit under ORS 316.116 if the first tax year for 13which the credit would otherwise be allowed with respect to an alternative energy device 14 begins on or after January 1, 2012. 15

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 8a, chapter 832, Oregon Laws 2005, as amended by section 13, chapter 913,
Oregon Laws 2009, is amended to read:

18 Sec. 8a. (1) The State Department of Energy may not issue a contractor's certification 19 certificate[, *alternative energy device system certificate*] or alternative fuel vehicle or related equip-20 ment certificate under ORS 469.170 after January 1, [2012] 2018.

(2) The State Department of Energy may not issue an alternative energy device system
certificate under ORS 469.170 after January 1, 2012.

- 23 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2011 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2011 24 regular session of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
