SUMMARY

Requires Department of Human Services to conduct study and report to Legislative Assembly during 2012 regular session on ways to streamline and expedite application process for long term care for individuals likely to meet financial criteria.

Relating to health care.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study the application process for long term care to investigate ways to streamline and expedite the process for individuals who are likely to meet the financial eligibility criteria. The department shall report to the Legislative Assembly during the 2012 regular session on its findings and shall present recommendations.
