Senate Bill 861

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene workgroup to investigate alternative delivery systems for health care services funded by Medicaid and to report findings and recommendations to 2012 regular session of Legislative Assembly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to delivery of Medicaid services. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall convene a workgroup to investigate 5 alternative delivery systems for health care services that are funded by Medicaid and shall 6 report the findings of the workgroup and any recommendations to the Legislative Assembly 7 in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than the date of the convening of the 2012 8 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010. 9 (2) The workgroup shall include providers and consumers of health care. 10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2012

regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.
