## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 868

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Prohibits application of certain criminal sentences to person who is tried as adult for crime committed before person was 15 years of age. [Applies to crimes committed on or after effective date of Act.]

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to crime; declaring an emergency; and providing for criminal sentence reduction that re-

3 quires approval by a two-thirds majority.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> ORS 137.700 and 137.707 do not apply to a person who is under 15 years of 6 age at the time the person commits a crime listed in ORS 137.700 or 137.707.

7 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act applies to persons sentenced on or after the ef-

8 fective date of this 2011 Act for a crime committed before, on or after the effective date of
9 this 2011 Act.

10 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 12 on its passage.
