

Senate Bill 875

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY (at the request of Oregon AFSCME)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Makes strikes or recognition of picket line of labor organization by assistant attorneys general unlawful.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to assistant attorneys general; amending ORS 243.736.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 243.736 is amended to read:

5 243.736. (1) It is unlawful for any of the following public employees to strike or recognize a
6 picket line of a labor organization while in the performance of official duties:

7 (a) **Assistant attorneys general;**

8 [(a)] (b) Deputy district attorneys;

9 [(b)] (c) Emergency telephone worker;

10 [(c)] (d) Employee of the Oregon Youth Authority who has custody, control or supervision of
11 youth offenders;

12 [(d)] (e) Firefighter;

13 [(e)] (f) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital;

14 [(f)] (g) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders; and

15 [(g)] (h) Police officer.

16 (2) As used in this section, "emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal
17 duties are receiving information through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 403.105 to
18 403.250, relaying the information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency
19 equipment or personnel in response to the information.
