SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public universities and community colleges to provide financial aid to students with unmet financial need under federal aid formula when university or community college raises tuition more than ______ percent.

2 Relating to postsecondary student financial aid.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) An institution of higher education listed in] ORS 352.002 or a community 4 college in this state must provide financial aid to pay for the unmet financial need of stu- $\mathbf{5}$ dents eligible to receive federal grants under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, 6 as amended, if the institution raises its tuition for an academic year to an amount that is 7 8 more than ____ <u>percent of the tuition charged by the institution for the previous aca</u> demic year. 9 (2) As used in this section, "unmet financial need" means the difference between a 10 student's cost of attending an institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 or a 11 12 community college in this state for an academic year and the sum of a student's expected family contribution plus all amounts of federal financial aid awarded as grants or loans to 13the student, as determined by a student's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) 14
