Requires person to remove personal information before selling or distributing used copy machine.

Makes violation unlawful trade practice.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** (1) As used in this section:
 - (a) "Person" has the meaning given that term in ORS 646.605.
- 6 (b)(A) "Personal information" means:
 - (i) An individual's last name and first name or first initial or Social Security number, driver license number or state identification card number issued by the Department of Transportation, passport number or other identification number issued by the United States or this state.
 - (ii) Information from which judgments can be made about an individual's character, habits, avocations, finances, occupations, general reputation, credit or other personal characteristics.
 - (iii) Financial account numbers, policy numbers, credit or debit card numbers, security codes, access codes, passwords that would permit access to an individual's financial information or accounts or other personal financial information.
 - (iv) Individually identifiable health information that relates to an individual's past, present or future physical or mental health or condition, the provision of health care to an individual or the past, present or future payment for the provision of health care to an individual.
 - (B) "Personal information" does not mean information, other than a Social Security number:
 - (i) In a federal, state or local government record that is lawfully made available to the public; or
 - (ii) That an individual has a reasonable basis to believe is lawfully made available to the public in widely distributed media or disclosures to the public that are required by federal, state or local law.
 - (c) "Used copy machine" means equipment that creates hard copies of documents that has been previously owned or used by another person.
 - (2) Any person engaged in the sale or distribution of used copy machines shall, before sale or delivery of a used copy machine to another person, remove, erase or otherwise de-

stroy any personal information that may be contained in or on any component of the used
copy machine that stores print or electronic data so that the personal information cannot
be read or reconstructed.

- (3) A person who violates subsection (2) of this section commits an unlawful practice under ORS 646.608 and is subject to enforcement and penalty as provided under ORS 646.605 to 646.652.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act applies to used copy machines sold or distributed on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
