

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 909

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 5, after “ensuring” delete the rest of the line and
2 insert “that all public school students in this state reach the education outcomes established for the
3 state. The board shall accomplish this goal by overseeing a”.

4 In line 8, after “(2)” insert “(a)”.

5 In line 9, delete “(a)” and insert “(A)”.

6 In line 10, delete “(b)” and insert “(B)”.

7 After line 12, insert:

8 “(b) When determining who to appoint to the board, the Governor shall:

9 “(A) Ensure that each congressional district of this state is represented by at least one member
10 of the board; and

11 “(B) Solicit recommendations from the Speaker of the House of Representatives for at least two
12 members and from the President of the Senate for at least two members.”.

13 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

14 “(b) Recommending strategic investments in order to ensure that the public education budget is
15 integrated and is targeted to achieve the education outcomes established for the state.”.

16 In line 4, delete “returns on investments” and insert “outcomes to determine the return on
17 statewide education investments”.

18 Delete lines 39 through 41 and insert:

19 “(3)(a) The council consists of nine members who are appointed by the Governor and serve at
20 the pleasure of the Governor.

21 “(b) When determining who to appoint to the council, the Governor shall:

22 “(A) Ensure that at least one of the members is an appointed member of the Oregon Education
23 Investment Board;

24 “(B) Ensure that each congressional district of this state is represented by at least one member
25 of the council;

26 “(C) For a member who is not an appointed member of the Oregon Education Investment Board,
27 ensure that the member meets the following qualifications:

28 “(i) Demonstrates leadership skills in civics or the member’s profession;

29 “(ii) To the greatest extent practicable, contributes to the council’s representation of the ge-
30 ographic, ethnic, gender, racial and economic diversity of this state; and

31 “(iii) Contributes to the council’s expertise, knowledge and experience in early childhood de-
32 velopment, early childhood care, early childhood education, family financial stability, populations
33 disproportionately burdened by poor education outcomes and outcome-based best practices; and

34 “(D) Solicit recommendations from the Speaker of the House of Representatives for at least two
35 members and from the President of the Senate for at least two members.”.

1 On page 3, line 22, after “services” insert “, to the extent that the special education and related
2 services affect early learning goals”.

3 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 3.

4 In line 4, delete “(d)” and insert “(c)”.

5 In line 7, delete “(e)” and insert “(d)”.

6 In line 8, delete “(f)” and insert “(e)”.

7 Delete lines 40 through 45.

8 On page 5, delete lines 1 through 29 and insert:

9 **“SECTION 8.** If Senate Bill 242 becomes law, section 1 of this 2011 Act is amended to read:

10 **“Sec. 1.** (1) The Oregon Education Investment Board is established for the purpose of ensuring
11 that all public school students in this state reach the education outcomes established for the state.
12 The board shall accomplish this goal by overseeing a unified public education system that begins
13 with early childhood services and continues throughout public education from kindergarten to
14 post-secondary education.

15 “(2)(a) The board consists of 13 members as follows:

16 “(A) The Governor, or the designee of the Governor; and

17 “(B) Twelve members who are appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate
18 in the manner provided in ORS 171.562 and 171.565, and who serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

19 “(b) When determining who to appoint to the board, the Governor shall:

20 “(A) Ensure that each congressional district of this state is represented by at least one member
21 of the board; and

22 “(B) Solicit recommendations from the Speaker of the House of Representatives for at least two
23 members and from the President of the Senate for at least two members.

24 “(3) The Governor, or the Governor’s designee, shall serve as chairperson of the Oregon Edu-
25 cation Investment Board.

26 “(4) The duties of the board include:

27 “(a) Ensuring that early childhood services are streamlined and connected to public education
28 from kindergarten through grade 12 and that public education from kindergarten through grade 12
29 is streamlined and connected to post-secondary education. To assist the board in fulfilling this duty,
30 the board shall oversee:

31 “(A) The Early Learning Council established by section 4 of this 2011 Act.

32 **“(B) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission established by section 1, chapter
33 ___, Oregon Laws 2011 (Enrolled Senate Bill 242).**

34 “(b) Recommending strategic investments in order to ensure that the public education budget is
35 integrated and is targeted to achieve the education outcomes established for the state.

36 “(c) Providing an integrated, statewide, student-based data system that monitors expenditures
37 and outcomes to determine the return on statewide education investments. The board shall provide
38 the data system described in this paragraph by:

39 “(A) Developing the data system or identifying or modifying an existing data system that ac-
40 complishes the goals of the data system; and

41 “(B) Ensuring that the data system is maintained.

42 “(5) An appointed member of the board is entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in
43 ORS 292.495.

44 “(6) A majority of the members of the board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of busi-
45 ness.

1 “(7) The board shall meet at such times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or
2 of a majority of the members of the board.

3 “(8) In accordance with applicable provisions of ORS chapter 183, the board may adopt rules
4 necessary for the administration of the laws that the board is charged with administering, **including**
5 **any rules necessary for the oversight of the direction and control of the Higher Education**
6 **Coordinating Commission.**”.

7 After line 31, insert:

8 **“SECTION 10. Sections 1 to 7 of this 2011 Act are repealed on March 15, 2016.**

9 **“SECTION 11. (1) On March 15, 2016, the Chief Education Officer of the Oregon Education**
10 **Investment Board shall deliver to the Chancellor of the Oregon University System all records**
11 **and property within the jurisdiction of the Chief Education Officer that relate to the duties,**
12 **functions and powers of the Oregon Education Investment Board. The Chancellor of the**
13 **Oregon University System shall take possession of the records and property.**

14 **“(2) On March 15, 2016, the Early Childhood System Director shall deliver to the Super-**
15 **intendent of Public Instruction all records and property within the jurisdiction of the Early**
16 **Childhood System Director that relate to the duties, functions and powers of the Early**
17 **Learning Council. The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall take possession of the re-**
18 **ords and property.**

19 **“(3) The Governor shall resolve any dispute between the Chief Education Officer and the**
20 **Chancellor of the Oregon University System, or the Early Childhood System Director and the**
21 **Superintendent of Public Instruction, relating to transfers of records and property under this**
22 **section, and the Governor’s decision is final.**

23 **“SECTION 12. On March 15, 2016, the unexpended balances of amounts authorized to be**
24 **expended by the Oregon Education Investment Board for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015,**
25 **from revenues dedicated, continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made avail-**
26 **able to the board for the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions and**
27 **powers of the board under sections 1 to 7 of this 2011 Act are transferred to the General**
28 **Fund to be available for general governmental expenses.”.**

29 In line 32, delete “10” and insert “13”.
