

Senate Bill 938

Sponsored by Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to produce caseload forecasts for programs administered by Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to forecasting; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. No later than March 1 and October 1 of each year, the Oregon Department**
5 **of Administrative Services shall produce a caseload forecast for programs administered by**
6 **the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority. The Governor shall**
7 **prepare the budget report required under ORS 291.216 using the caseload forecasts prepared**
8 **by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services under this section.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is intended to transfer all caseload forecasting**
10 **functions for programs administered by the Department of Human Services and the Oregon**
11 **Health Authority from the department and the authority to the Office of Economic Analysis**
12 **in the Oregon Department of Administrative Services.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
