

Senate Bill 939

Sponsored by Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Emergency Board for allocation to Oregon Health Authority for caseload growth in Oregon Health Plan Plus program occurring in second fiscal year of biennium. Requires authority to report to Legislative Assembly on accuracy of caseload growth projection made in 2011.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
5 **priated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General**
6 **Fund, the amount of \$_____, to be allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for caseload**
7 **growth in the Oregon Health Plan Plus program that occurs during the second year of the**
8 **biennium.**

9 **(2) The authority shall report to the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly during its 2012**
10 **regular session on the accuracy of the caseload growth projection made in 2011 for the sec-**
11 **ond fiscal year of the biennium to enable the Legislative Assembly to reevaluate the need for**
12 **additional moneys for caseload growth in the second fiscal year of the biennium.**

13 **(3) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**
14 **by the Emergency Board or the Legislative Assembly prior to December 1, 2012, the moneys**
15 **remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board**
16 **lawfully may allocate funds.**

17 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2011.**
