## Senate Bill 942

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt plan and rules and state agencies to perform certain actions related to sustainability. Requires state agencies to reduce amount of paper purchased each year for internal operations, beginning on specified date.

Clarifies statutory requirements relating to state waste paper collection program.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sustainability; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 459A.480.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 4

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 $\mathbf{5}$ (a) "State agency" means any state board, commission or department, except those in 6 the legislative and judicial branches.

7 (b) "Sustainability" has the meaning given that term in ORS 184.421.

8 (2) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares that state agency internal operations 9 consume significant resources and supplies and that those operations should be conducted 10 in a manner that minimizes their negative impact on Oregon's environment, economy and 11 communities.

12(3) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall adopt and annually update a plan by which state agencies must implement the goals related to sustainability listed in 13 14 ORS 184.423. The plan must:

15(a) Include strategies for creating a culture of sustainability for employees of state 16 agencies; and

17 (b) Establish guidelines for developing, monitoring and expanding sustainable operations 18 in state agencies, including guidelines for the sustainable use of state-owned facilities, vehicles and information technology. 19

20 (4) To assist state agencies in achieving the goals listed in ORS 184.423, the department 21shall:

22(a) Provide state agency employees with information on sustainable practices, including 23 greenhouse gas reduction strategies, resource conservation strategies and the recycling 24 practices required in ORS 459A.480;

25 (b) Establish programs for training state agency employees on how to implement those 26 strategies and recycling practices; and

27 (c) Schedule and convene meetings between state agencies for the purpose of collaborat-28ing on sustainability programs and practices.

29 (5) Each state agency shall, in consultation with the department, create and maintain a 30 Green Team Program by which employees of the state agency may voluntarily organize for 1 the purpose of participating in activities related to sustainability.

2 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) As used in this section, "state agency" means any state board, commis-3 sion or department, except those in the legislative and judicial branches.

4 (2) A state agency shall purchase during each calendar year at least 20 percent less paper 5 for internal operations than the state agency purchased for internal operations during the 6 2009 calendar year.

7 (3) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall adopt rules to implement
8 this section.

9 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to purchases of paper by a state agency
10 made on or after July 1, 2015.

11 SECTION 4. ORS 459A.480 is amended to read:

12459A.480. (1) For the [current] state waste paper collection program, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, in consultation with the Department of Environmental Quality, shall provide 13 participating locations with public awareness information and training to state and legislative em-14 15 ployees, including but not limited to the proper separation and disposal of recycled resources. Ad-16 ditionally, the [Oregon Department of Administrative Services, in consultation with the Department of Environmental Quality,] department shall provide training for personnel, including but not limited 17 18 to state buildings and grounds personnel responsible for the collection of waste materials. [This 19 training shall include but is] The training must include, but need not be limited to, educating and 20 training the personnel [concerning] on the separation and collection of recyclable materials.

(2) The [Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall continue the current] **department shall administer a** state waste paper collection program for employees of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111. This program shall include recycling opportunities for office paper, corrugated cardboard, newsprint, beverage containers as defined in ORS 459A.700, container glass, mixed waste paper, plastic bottles, waste oil, clay-coated materials, batteries, toner and printer cartridges and any other material at the discretion of the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services[, *in consultation with the Department of Environmental Quality*].

28 (3) The [Oregon] department [of Administrative Services] may:

(a) Consult with the Department of Environmental Quality in implementing this section;
and

31 (b) Contract as necessary for the recycling of products returned under [subsections (1) and (2)
32 of] this section.

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
