

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 952

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 24 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1)(a) A supervising physician or supervising physician organization may**
3 **apply to the Oregon Medical Board for authority for a physician assistant to dispense drugs**
4 **specified by the supervising physician or supervising physician organization.**

5 **“(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, a physician assistant may not**
6 **dispense controlled substances classified in schedules I through IV under the federal Con-**
7 **trolled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. 811 and 812, as modified under ORS 475.035.**

8 **“(2) The board shall adopt rules establishing standards and qualifications for physician**
9 **assistants with dispensing authority. The rules must require:**

10 **“(a) A physician assistant seeking dispensing authority to complete a drug dispensing**
11 **training program; and**

12 **“(b) The supervising physician or supervising physician organization that applies for dis-**
13 **persing authority for a physician assistant to:**

14 **“(A) Provide the board with a plan for drug delivery and control;**

15 **“(B) Submit an annual report to the board on the physician assistant’s use of dispensing**
16 **authority; and**

17 **“(C) Submit a list of the drugs or classes of drugs that the supervising physician or**
18 **supervising physician organization proposes to authorize the physician assistant to dispense.**

19 **“(3) The Oregon Medical Board, in collaboration with the State Board of Pharmacy, shall**
20 **develop a drug dispensing training program for physician assistants.**

21 **“(4) Drugs dispensed by a physician assistant with dispensing authority under this section**
22 **must be personally dispensed by the physician assistant.”.**
