**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Declares [*June 19 to June 25, 2011,*] **last week in April of each year to be Oregon Dance Week.**

**CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

2       Whereas dance contributes to the well-being of individuals who watch dance performances and  
3 those who dance; and

4       Whereas dance and opportunities to go dancing lend vibrancy and vitality to the community;  
5 and

6       Whereas dance festivals bring immense value to the people of a community by encouraging them  
7 to be active, to be healthy and to celebrate life; and

8       Whereas National Dance Week was founded in 1981 to increase awareness of dance and its  
9 contributions to our national culture; and

10       Whereas the goal of National Dance Day is to inspire everyone from top-notch dancers to people  
11 with two left feet to get up and exercise; and

12       Whereas National Dance Day was considered by a Congressional resolution in 2010 (House Re-  
13 solution 1514) to promote health and self-esteem through the art form of dance; and

14       Whereas spring is a fine time of year to meet new friends and to renew old friendships through  
15 dancing; now, therefore,

16 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

17       We, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, declare the last week in April of  
18 each year to be Oregon Dance Week.
