4 Whereas dance and opportunities to go dancing lend vibrancy and vitality to the community; 5 and

6 Whereas dance festivals bring immense value to the people of a community by encouraging them 7 to be active, to be healthy and to celebrate life; and

8 Whereas National Dance Week was founded in 1981 to increase awareness of dance and its 9 contributions to our national culture; and

10 Whereas the goal of National Dance Day is to inspire everyone from top-notch dancers to people 11 with two left feet to get up and exercise; and

Whereas National Dance Day was considered by a Congressional resolution in 2010 (House Resolution 1514) to promote health and self-esteem through the art form of dance; and
