Declares June 19 to June 25, 2011, Oregon Dance Week.

8	Whereas National Dance Week was founded in 1981 to increase awareness of dance and its
9	contributions to our national culture; and
10	Whereas the goal of National Dance Day is to inspire everyone from top-notch dancers to people
11	with two left feet to get up and exercise; and
12	Whereas National Dance Day was considered by a Congressional resolution in 2010 (House Re
13	solution 1514) to promote health and self-esteem through the art form of dance; and
14	Whereas June is a fine time of year to meet new friends and to renew old friendships through
15	dancing; now, therefore,
16	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
17	We, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, declare June 19 to June 25, 2011
18	to be Oregon Dance Week.
