Work Session

SB 111

Establishes statewide audio newspaper service for individuals who are blind or print-disabled.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SR 1

Urges United States Secretary of Health and Human Services to designate as preventive services all contraceptive drugs and devices approved for use by United States Food and Drug Administration to exempt drugs and devices from cost-sharing requirements imposed by insurers.

SB 493

Directs certain health care regulatory boards to require certain health care providers to complete continuing education about clinical breast examinations.

SB 433

Expands eligibility for medical assistance for low-income and uninsured women diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer.

SB 723

Changes name of Respiratory Therapist Licensing Board to Respiratory Therapist and Polysomnographic Technologist Licensing Board.
