Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4098 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires that annual timber harvest on state forestlands in each subject forest district equal specified percentage of annual amount of harvestable timber expected to be grown on state forestlands in district.
- HB 4089
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows owner of territory not contiguous to city to annex to city if land is within 500 feet of existing city boundary and city was under jurisdiction of boundary commission on January 1, 2007.
- HB 4119 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to recommend rules to State Fish and Wildlife Commission regarding creation of pilot program that allows persons to use dogs to hunt or pursue cougars.

- HB 4090
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/9/2012 AGENDA: Authorizes owner of real property that is located within urban growth boundary and, due to certain impediments, not provided with sanitary sewer or water services to cause public or private provider of sanitary sewer and water services to connect service facilities and serve property if owner pays all costs to connect and deliver service.
- HB 4072
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/9/2012 AGENDA: Allows forest protective association to contract with Department of Transportation for association seasonal fire prevention and suppression personnel to render off-season services to department that indirectly facilitate fire prevention and suppression.
- HB 4158
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/9/2012 AGENDA: Allows killing of wolves to address depredation of livestock.
