Public Hearing

HB 4094

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING. Replaces requirement that person licensed by Construction Contractors Board as exempt commercial contractor procure workers' compensation coverage with requirement that person make statement verifying workers' compensation coverage.

HB 4092

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING. Allows licensed distillery or trade association representing distilleries to obtain license for special event at which multiple distilleries may permit tastings and conduct limited sales.

HB 4053

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING. Modifies types of animals qualifying as assistance animals for purposes of accessing places of public accommodation and modes of transportation and for purposes of cause of action for harm to assistance animal.
