Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4055

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs state agencies and local governments with functions related to issuance of registrations, licenses, certifications or permits necessary to conduct business in Oregon to provide nonmonetary assistance to qualified persons.

HB 4108

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes precious material secondhand dealer record keeping requirements regarding transactions involving items of precious material.

Work Session

HB 4035

Amends provisions of Oregon law to conform to changes in Uniform Commercial Code, to clarify meaning of name of debtor, to permit filing of information statement, to adopt official filing forms, to specify priority of competing secured claims and to address related matters.
