CARRIED OVER FROM 2/8/2012 AGENDA - Creates Central Oregon Psychiatric Prescribing Program as pilot program to allow reimbursement of mental health drug costs using capitation payment methodology.

#### Public Hearing

SB 1509  
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/8/2012 AGENDA - Provides legislative approval of Oregon Health Authority proposals for coordinated care organizations and Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation business plan for health insurance exchange by repealing provisions of law enacted to require legislative approval.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1570  
Requires medical assistance coverage of prescription drugs that are immunosuppressant drugs or drugs for treatment of seizures, cancer, HIV or AIDS.

SB 1562  
Requires Oregon Health Authority, Department of Human Services and Public Employees' Benefit Board to develop goals, benchmarks and plans to address diabetes, diabetes care and complications from diabetes.
